

Cambridge Technical Extended Certificate in IT (Level 2)

>> Course Overview

The Cambridge TEC in IT offers a wide range of units such as installing hardware, creating a website, identifying an IT fault, computer animation and e-commerce. It is an ideal foundation if you wish to enter the workplace, providing you with a theoretical background reinforced with practical skills that transfer into the modern workplace. This course is offered as part of a package to students who haven't yet met the requirements to complete a level 3 program of study.

>> Entry Requirements

- Your need four GCSEs at mainly E's and D's or above.
- An interest and aptitude for the subject,
- Each application will be considered on an individual basis.

>> Course Structure

You have 5 hours of study and will complete 4 units over 1 year.

Communicating in the IT industry

This unit identifies the different IT tools available for safe and secure communication and exchange of information within an organisation. This unit will prepare you to use various communication channels effectively within a working environment.

Working in the IT industry

In this unit, you will investigate the types of job roles available in the IT industry and what the industry is looking for in prospective employees.

Website development

This unit will prepare you to design, create and test a fully functioning website to providing the basic knowledge of the components that aid web accessibility.

Multimedia design

The unit will prepare you to design, create, test and review your own multimedia application and will provide you with an understanding of planning and developing multimedia products.

>> Other Options

GCE Applied ICT Single Award (H315) –

Studied over two years, 6 units are taken and on successful completion an A2 grade is awarded. Suitable for students with a general interest in ICT.

BTEC Level 3 Subsidiary Diploma / Diploma in IT –

More hands on approach to IT, equivalent to 1 or 2 A-Levels with no exams.

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
